## PROCEDURE FOR REGISTERING A TOURIST SITE OR ATTRACTION

#### **Purpose and Context**

The Gombe State Ministry of Trade, Industry & Tourism is committed to promoting tourism as a key driver of economic development. This guideline outlines the steps for registering natural, cultural, or man-made sites as official tourist attractions to ensure proper documentation, preservation, and development.

#### Law

In pursuant to Gombe State Revenue (Codification and Consolidation) Law 2021, the following process and guidelines are laid down

# Step 1: Confirm Eligibility

Ensure that the site or attraction meets the following criteria:

- Has historical, cultural, ecological, or recreational significance.
- Is accessible to the public.
- Complies with Gombe State environmental and safety regulations.

## **Step 2: Obtain and Complete Application Form**

- Visit the **Gombe State Ministry of Trade, Industry & Tourism** at OLD GOMBE LGA SECRETARIAT, DUKKU ROAD GOMBE STATE
- Fill out the form with accurate information about the site or attraction.

# **Step 3: Prepare Supporting Documents**

Applicants must attach the following documents to their application:

- 1. **Ownership or Authorisation Letter**: Proof of ownership or permission from the landowner/community leader.
- 2. **Site Description Report**: Detailed description of the site, including its historical or cultural significance.
- 3. **Environmental Impact Clearance**: Certification from the Ministry of Environment confirming minimal ecological disruption.
- 4. Safety Assessment Report: Certification of compliance with safety standards.
- 5. **Photographs or Media**: High-quality images or videos showcasing the site.

## **Step 4: Pay Application Fee**

- Pay the non-refundable application fee of N10,000 at the Ministry's payment desk at OLD GOMBE LGA SECRETARIAT, DUKKU ROAD GOMBE STATE
- Attach the payment receipt to your application.

## **Step 5: Submit the Application**

- Submit the completed form and all supporting documents to the **Tourism Development Unit** of the Ministry at OLD GOMBE LGA SECRETARIAT, DUKKU ROAD GOMBE STATE
- Ensure that you receive an acknowledgment slip with a reference number for tracking purposes.

# **Step 6: Site Inspection and Assessment**

- The Ministry will schedule a site visit within **7 working days** of application submission.
- Officials will assess the site for accessibility, safety, and significance.
- The inspection report will be finalised within 5 working days of the visit.

# **Step 7: Approval and Registration**

- If the site meets all requirements, it will be approved as a registered tourist attraction.
- Applicants will receive a **Certificate of Registration** within **14 working days** of approval.
